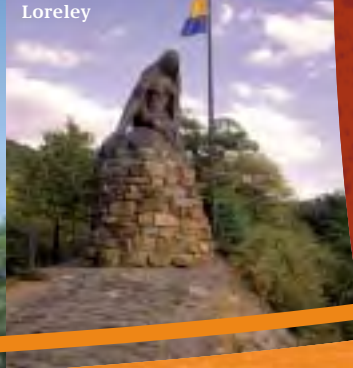

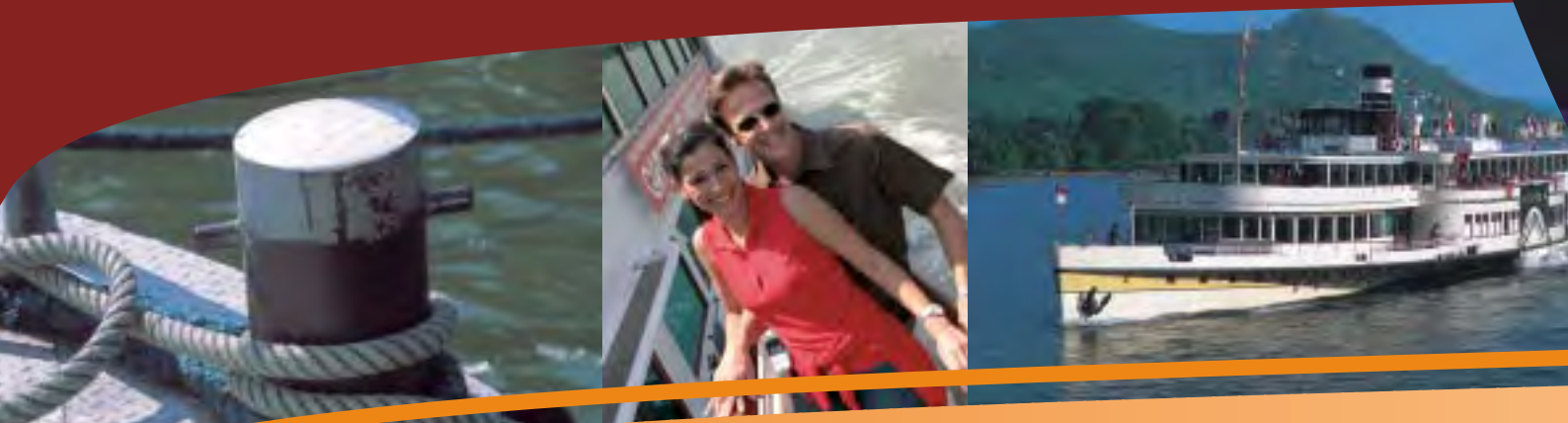
time for Romance

Journeys back in time

For 'sword and crown'! Here, on the Rhine, men have fought their battles and defended their castles, plundered where they could and levied tax where they could. Even today, the forty or so castles and fortresses, fortifications and defences speak of the importance of the river's course through the country as a narrow waterway for the transport of goods, and in the past were most desirable targets for those who could tax them from their vantage points in the hills above.

The Rhine flows through what can be called a real valley of kings and kaisers. Only a few kilometres away from Boppard town lies the 'Königsstuhl' (King's Throne) where, in the Middle Ages, kings were elected and where many succeeding regent climbed this way to pay his respects at a coronation. The majority of the castles

were built by power hungry electors like those of Cologne, Mainz and Trier, men who also erected many another fortifications in the area. Boppard's Elector's Castle on the banks of the Rhine also looks back to these old times. In fact, Boppard provides the perfect point of departure back to a time of knights, minnesingers and tales of yore. And as for the castles, these are like so many

pearls on a string: famous fortifications like that at Marksburg the 'Two Hostile Brothers', Sterrenberg and Liebenstein, the fortresses Katz and Maus to mention but a few. Each supplies a splendid view over the valley and their stones tell a tale at every turn of the noble men and women who once lived there.

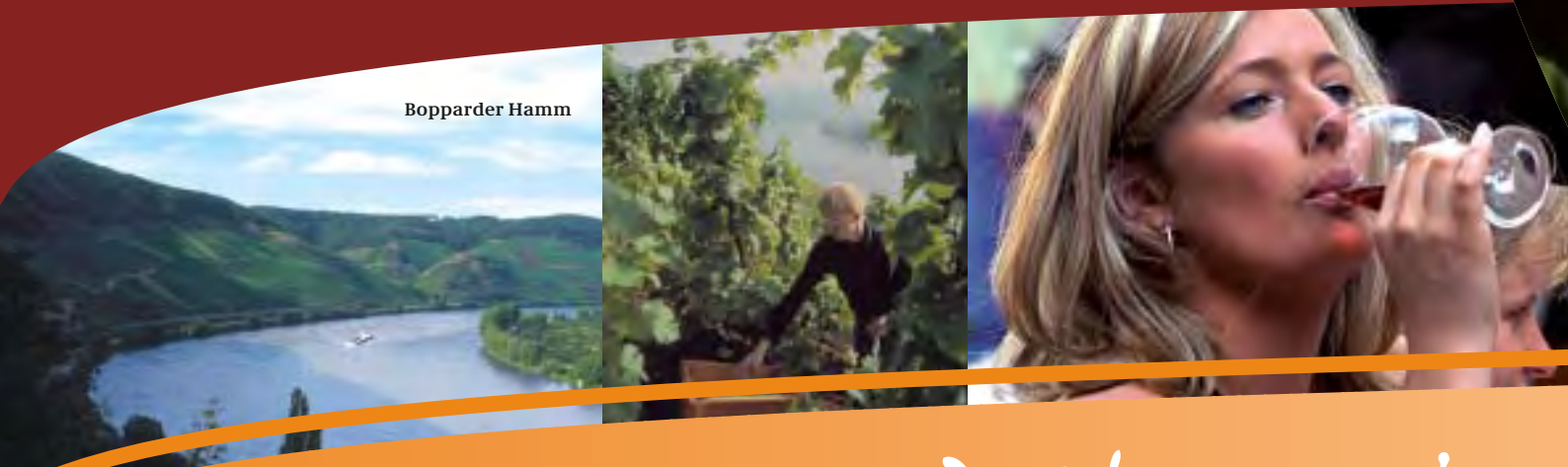
In vino veritas, they say when it comes to wine, and to be sure there's a whole lot of truth revealed in partaking the wines grown in Boppard's large vineyard at Hamm, not least in their subtlety and play of aroma. It is here that some of the finest wines of the middle Rhine region are grown, proving each year how well they 'go down' both for guests and inhabitants of these parts.

The winegrower's year is a hard one, but when a gentle climate, good soils and the expertise of winegrower and cellarer combine on Boppard's Hamm, then something quite wonderful is the result. Younger generations of winegrowers, too, can demonstrate what a first-class wine tastes like and how very clearly the origin and

type of grape is reflected in the delights of its bouquet. Boppard has been associated with winegrowing for centuries, and offers its delectable wines in the local cuisine, at wine-tasting get-togethers in vintner courtyards, at the Boppard Wine Festival in September or even in the middle of a vineyard as at the Middle Rhine Spring Wine Festival, which takes place at the end of April. The local Riesling grape is the star of wines growing on the Rhine and feels parti-

cularly at home here to give rise to a fine, racy wine. There is time to taste them at ease all through the year in the shady lanes and cosy parlour pubs of the town.

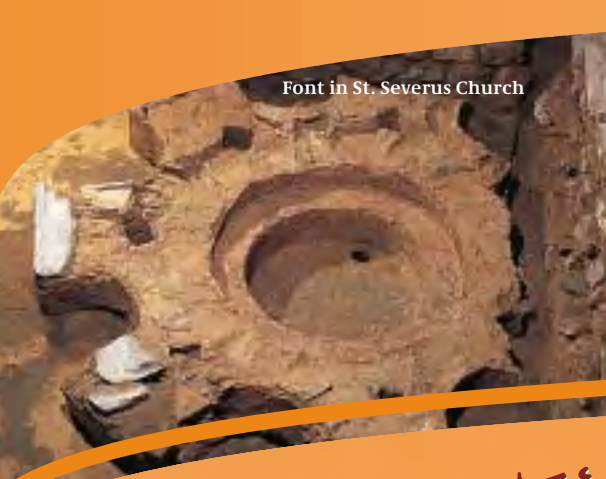

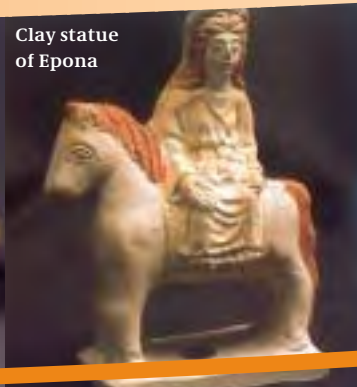

Approximately 2000 years of Roman history between Mainz and Koblenz have left a rich inheritance to the region, and it is not only the wine which the Romans brought here that claims our attention in an array of cultural heritage left by this Mediterranean civilisation. 'Bodobrica' was once the name given to Boppard in around 360 AD and the impressive fort erected by the Romans is testimony of its former greatness. What we see today as its remains belongs to the best-preserved castles north of the Alps. The twenty-eight towers and eight-metre high walls tell of a turbulent history. More than

thirty graves found in the Castle's interior dating back to the 7th century AD are witness to extensive settlement in Boppard, and also give some idea of how early Christian communities developed subsequent to Roman occupation and later. Numerous contemporary finds are exhibited in the city's museum and in the Elector's Castle Museum. These bring the culture of this time to life. Re-live the times of the town's origin yourself, and allow yourself to be surprised by your discoveries.

Time for Impressions

Boppard's history is similar to that of a walk through almost 2000 years of occupation and culture. The original Roman fortress wall was folded into the medieval city wall, and lengths of it are still pretty well preserved. Within the ancient building itself there are still wonderful chances of discovering things for yourself.

Romans and early Christians, Franconian tribes, later the French and the Prussians have all left their traces here. While emperors, monarchs and noblemen have come and gone in their time, traders, boatmen and bargees, ferrymen and others have accompanied them down the ages. All of them once gave the city its heyday in

the Middle Ages. The Electoral Castle, the Provost at Hirzenbach and St. Severus Church, as well as the beautifully timbered buildings of the Old Town, here and there dotted with 18th century baroque churches all decorate the town, all add to its elegance, and do much to invite the guest to relax and take it all in. A stroll through this town goes back to the time of the 'Rhine romance' along the promenade on whose flanks the

fine villas and guesthouses now stand. These give the city a Mediterranean flair and it's not for nothing that the town has been called the 'Nice on the Rhine'. However, la dolce vita does not simply have to do with the fashionable priorities of the past, but with the palpable present.

Walking the Rhine Castle Trail from Boppard



In 13 day-tours the Rhine Castle Trail winds up- and downhill, past craggy cliffs and medieval castles with breathtaking views of the romantic River Rhine. Follow the fascinating sagas and legends on one of the loveliest stretches along the ca. 24 km from Boppard to St. Goar and experience a walking tour through a magnificent natural landscape. For the return trip to Boppard you can enjoy a cruise on the Rhine.

You will lodge in a 3-star hotel or B&B directly in the town centre. On the first evening you will be treated to a wine tasting at which you can sample delicious wines from the Bopparder Hamm vineyards. On the last day, after a hearty breakfast, the tour continues with an exciting chair-lift ride up to two lookout points with fantastic views, Vierseenblick and Gedeonseck.

High above the Rhine

Boppard is not just the destination of a Rhine tour, but also the perfect point of departure for excursions of discovery, which begins with good, firm shoes and a rucksack. The RheinBurgenWeg connects the finest castles and historical places of interest en route and in Boppard itself it offers a special sport feature in the form of the 'Klettersteig'. Climbing rungs, ladders and steel cords are an accompaniment to this very special challenge providing excitement and adventure. On the right bank of the Rhine, and with the ferry only stone's throw away from Boppard, the 'Rheinsteig' offers wanderers a climb of

high standard of climbing. Actually, the route is over 320 kilometres long and leads from Wiesbaden to Bonn. However, probably the most impressive stretch of this path is that lying above the Loreley Valley, which is on Boppard's doorstep so to speak. In addition, a number of beautiful circular paths passing through woodland belonging to the town or through the orchards, vineyard terraces and meadows elegantly round off this selection of rambling opportunities.

time to enjoy cycling

Actually, the Rhine itself shows the way. Those who don't happen to have a map with them just cycle along the river and eventually come to their destination. There are cycling routes on both banks of the Rhine, and both of them are a pleasure, whatever your condition. For those who aspire to challenges, the mountain bike routes around Boppard are there for taking.

For some, happiness in life is on the back of a horse, but the cycle paths along the Rhine provide the finest conditions for those who are firm in the saddle when it comes to biking. With the glittering waves of the Rhine as a neighbour, the cycle paths run through Boppard and are well signposted. At the same time, they offer a pleasant point of departure for making discoveries on two wheels. Whether we want a comfortable roll or strenuously put the kilometres behind us, we always have the superlative landscape in view. As far as the mountain bike routes are concerned, the route takes us over rough terrain through the Stadtwald, and it's here that quick reactions and plenty of muscle is needed. Those

who feel they want to belong to the real professionals in this sport should try the Downhill/Freeride section from Vierseenblick high above Boppard. Adrenalin and the experience of the countryside racing by take place here as quickly as the gears on the bike are changed!

Rhine Express, Boppard

There's a lot going on in Boppard. While the mini-rail 'Rheinexpress' rolls through the town's lanes, presenting the visitor with the most interesting spots there, the Hunsrück Railway (1908) for its part clambers up the steep viaducts and over the bridges of the Hunsrück region. It's here that the challenging cycle route waits for the brave biker. One can get uphill quickest by using the seat lift and so reach the Gedeonseck lookout point and that of the famous Vierseenblick. And it's from here, too, that the paragliders slip into the local thermic airs to breeze and wheel like birds at a great height over the Rhine Valley. It's from this vantage point of course that one can catch a glimpse of the 18-hole Jakobsberg golf course in all its fresh greenness, a

place which stands for another 'earthy' passion, a place of holes and handicaps. The championships course was set up on a Rhine terrace near Boppard in the 90s. From here, one has a unique view over to Westerwald, Taunus and Hunsrück as well as Marksburg – and of course into the Rhine Valley below. The course was moved here and realised by the American golf-course architect, Robert Trent Jones jr.

time for the unknown

Boppard indeed is a place that offers enough ideas and attractions to enable the guest to spend a holiday free from care. However, anyone who casts a glance over its walls can expect to find the most delightful attractions in towns, on the river or in land. A really very simple journey through one of Germany's most beautiful regions awaits discovery.

One route could be from cathedral to cathedral, that is, from Mainz to Cologne. Both cities are not only cities pulsing with life, but both have a history, which goes back some 2000 years. Those who want to

avoid the big city can find romantic little places and many interesting spots to see among the vineyards of Rheingau, Rheinhessen and Nahe. On the other hand, the central mountainous area between Hunsrück and Taunus offers heavenly peace, wide vistas and primordial beauty among the

blowing ears of corn in the fields, the quiet woods and yellow rape fields stretching to the horizon.

Abseiling/Rappelling in Two Variations

You can vertically descend down the tower with an abseil device as in classic abseiling, or you can be lowered on a diagonal cable that has been attached to the tower at a 45° angle, thus suspending you in mid-air on your way down. Australian rappelling is a new sport trend in which one descends the wall of a tall building on a fixed rope in a standing position while facing the ground. In our case it's not the wall of a building but the Sauerlingsturm, an old watchtower located at the Boppard train station.

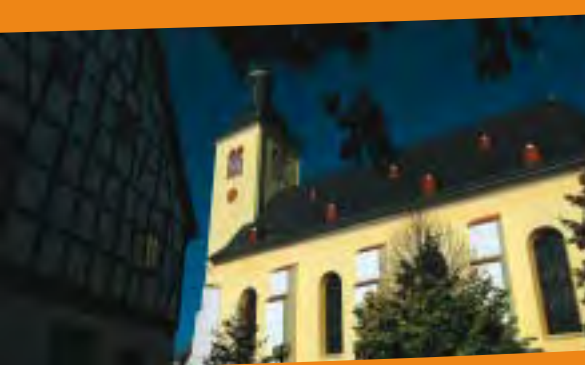

The stars shown are a symbol for controlled performance features. Accommodation is divided into five categories as follows:

1-star	simple but adequate furnishing

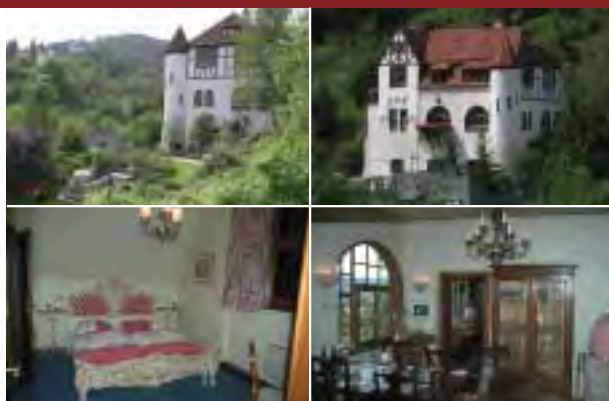

General Conditions (AGB)

Dear Guest,

We are pleased to know that you want to spend your holiday in Boppard. In order to avoid misunderstanding and difficulty, we ask you kindly to read the following. Thank you!

1. Rights and commitments taken from the contracts pertaining to guest accommodation and that of the negotiation of special offers

The Tourist Information (TI) centre in Boppard is only entitled to negotiate on behalf of the concerns offering accommodation and those serving them. Contracts are arranged between those entitled to perform their functions in their name and on their account. The TI is solely a mediator. Its contracting partner is its host.

2. The contract pertaining to taking in guests

- a) The contract is considered as concluded when a room is booked or promised or, should a promise be no more valid for time reasons, already put ready for occupation.
- b) The conclusion of the said contract of acceptance of a guest commits the contracted partner to fulfil the agreed contract, regardless of how long the contract has been concluded.
- c) The host as contracted party is obliged to conform with the legal regulations relating to the accommodation of guests.
- d) The guest for his part is legally required in the case where he/she does not take advantage of the contracted agreement to pay the agreed price or the usual price previously set down in this arrangement. The host will deduct what he has not spent in the agreement. This legally allows the host to charge 80% of the agreed amount for an overnight stay with breakfast in

the case of full board. The same is valid in the case of apartment contracts where 60% may be charged (maximum 90%) in the case where accommodation services (overnight stays) are not claimed.

- e) The host is morally obliged not to keep back rooms, which have not been booked so as to be able to hire them out at a future date, thus, where possible, avoiding cancellations.
- f) The guest is obliged to pay for the room as contractually agreed until such time as the room is hired out for use by another guest.

In their own interests, we recommend that guests insure themselves against the possibility of sudden cancellation. Forms are available at the Boppard Tourist Information Office.

3. Conditions of payment

In the case where rooms and accommodation is negotiated by the TI, the terms of payment are regulated by those (hotel etc.) providing the accommodation. Where there are special offers or all-in-one offers for accommodation and services, the conditions governing terms of payment appearing in the booking are valid.

4. Guarantees and Liability

We undertake the proper management of your requests and their passing on to the appropriate bodies. In this, the TI Boppard is only liable in the case of gross negligence or deliberate misma-




agement. We cannot be held responsible for the incidence of natural catastrophe, strikes or communication disturbances connected with the German Telekom. In addition, the TI is not responsible for mistakes or offence(s) on the part of the businesses (hotels etc.), their service personnel or others recommended by it. For the settlement of such as disputes arising from such issues, the jurisdiction is in Koblenz.

5. To be noted in every case:




